# 5. Subscription Claim

From this year, Council has decided that all formal CTC Member Groups should be able to access a reasonable sum of money to support the basic administrative costs of running a group. This will be a flat rate of £200 for 2011-12 - half of this year's claimants will see an increase in payments.

Larger Member Groups that have received a larger sum in the past will not see a reduction for 5 years and thereafter may continue to ask for more funds through a special grant application process. It is likely around half of this year's claimants will benefit from this policy.

All Member Groups can ask for more money through the special grant application process. All additional funding must only be used for the purposes for which it is requested and Member Groups must report on its use in their Annual Return to CTC Council. Locally raised money is entirely at the discretion of the Member Group to manage.
