

CTC Devon Events Report 2014/2015

22 events formed this years CTC Devon Tourist Competition, starting with the Dartmoor Devil on 26th October and concluding on 13th September with the 100 miles in 8/10 hours.

The 8 Cat A events proved the most popular with 3 of them attracting over 150 entries each. The Cat E events (Treasure Hunt, Pace Judging and Freewheeling) were only getting small numbers of members competing even though the event that requires the least physical effort. Devon Dirt while having about 300 entries, very few were members of the CTC.

170 members competed in one or more event either as a marshal or a competitor. 8 members took part in 8 or more events and a further 6 competed in 6 or more events.

The Overall and Team competition was undecided until the final few events with the lead changing on more than one occasion.

Graham Brodie, Gill Simmonds and the XXX Team of Mike Watson, Jill Day and Rob Simmonds won their respective sections and each will receive a £30 voucher from a local bike shop.

For 2015/2016 we have 16 events planned. Unfortunately we have lost the Treasure Hunt, the Coast to Coast, the Coast and Back, plus a 160k, a 200k and a 300k audax events.

A 60k ride has been added in February, the St Valentines Day Massacre by CTC Torbay. A leaflet detailing all the events for the coming year will be published in December.
