

C T C Torbay Report 2013/2014

Numbers continue to grow on both the Sunday rides and Tuesday morning rides. Normally 20/25 members at the start on both days and numbers have exceeded 30.

Two weekend trips to France took place. A weekend in Le Faou in October 2013 and also a weekend in Normandy last May. Both events well supported and further trips to France are being planned for 2015. A further trip to Spain with seven members took place in September,

Two Christmas Lunches took place in December, one for the Sunday riders and another for the Tuesday group.

Bar-B-Que held in July attracted over 50 members, but unfortunately the Skittles was cancelled due to lack of venue.

Five car assisted rides took place over the summer to such places as Watchet, Winkleigh and Dulverton and were generally well supported. Similar rides are planned for 2015.

Wednesday Evening Rides were better supported during the year than in the past with numbers often in double figures for the ride to a local pub.

The section also organised during the year eleven events in the CTC Devon Tourist Competition .
