

## **CTC Devon Annual General Meeting – November 2012**

### **Event Secretary's report**

This year's tourist competition comprised 18 events including 5 new additions and 1 omission.

Unfortunately the Treasure Hunt was not held this year but the new events included a small part of the Great Tour of Britain at Seaton, a Hospiscare ride at Tiverton and the Totnes Taster.

All of the results are now in apart from the recent Dartmoor Devil. So far this year the events have attracted 102 CTC Devon members riding at least one event, 37 riding 2 or more and 21 riding 3 or more. The competition has been closely fought between 7 members who have ridden 5 or more events with the final outcome dependant on the Dartmoor Devil result. Provisional results from the Dartmoor Devil indicate that Kevin Presland has won the individual points competition for the year.

The team competition has been dominated by South Devon with all 3 of their teams in the top 3 but it looks like a new team, Babyshambles, will push The Denbury Triangle into second place this year.

The CTC Devon support for the events varied from 27 in the Mad March 100k to only 4 or 5 in the longer events although most events were supported by non CTC Devon members. The freewheel/hillclimb had a record low turnout this year of only 4 people in poor weather, using a new course on a different day. Hopefully the new venue will attract more support next year.

The Events website has been kept up to date throughout the season as results have been provided by event organisers. I would like to thank all of the organisers for keeping me posted with the results and for their hard work organising the events with their small band of volunteers.

After 7 years in the role, including 5 years compiling the Events Wiki pages, this will be my last year with CTC Devon having recently relocated to North Somerset. I wish you continued success with all of the events.
